

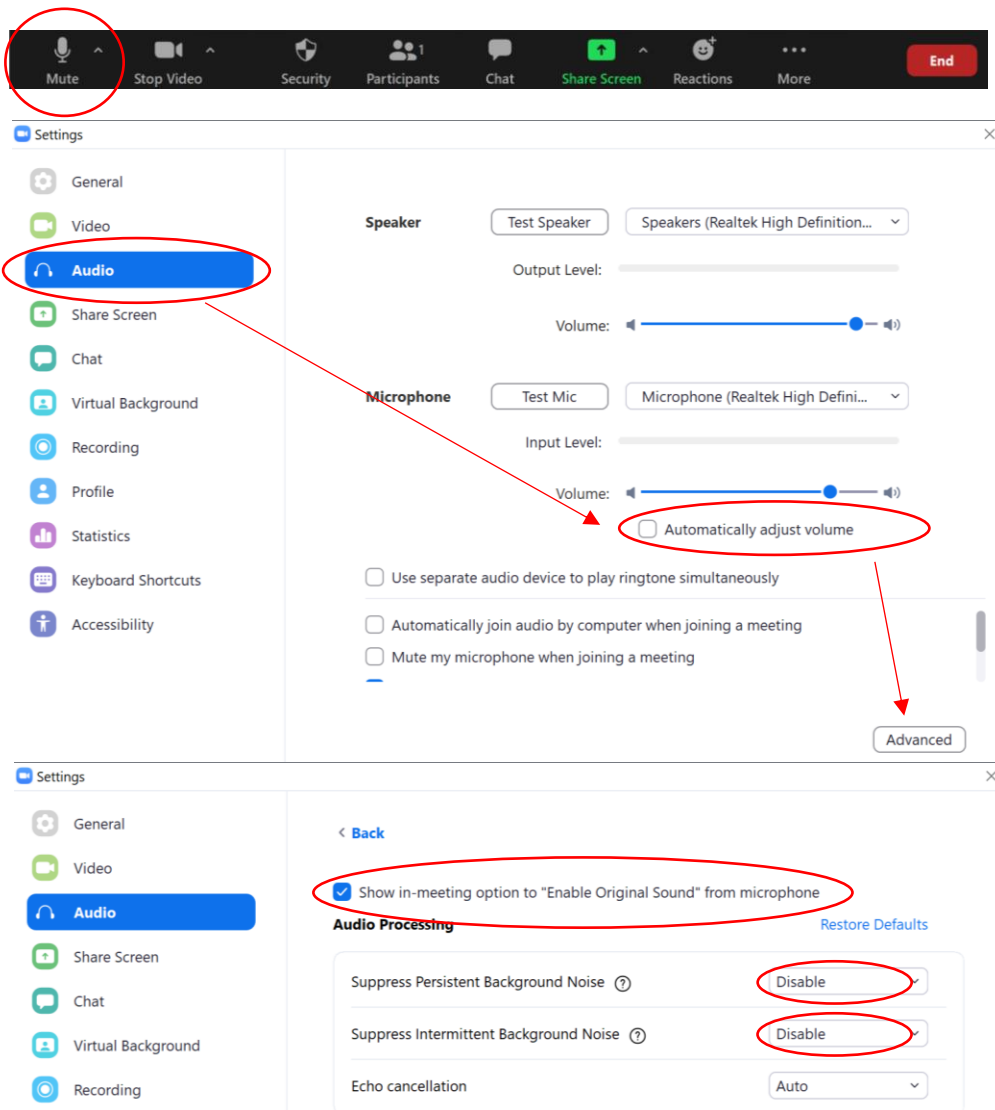
ZOOM MEETINGS

HOW TO ADJUST YOUR SOUND SETTINGS IF USING A COMPUTER

(Make sure your volume is turned up on your computer)

Pull up the menu next to the mic icon, click Audio Settings. Then the next menu that pulls up, under Microphone, you should UNCHECK “automatically adjust volume”. Then in the lower right corner of that menu, you should click “Advanced”. On the new menu, you should click “enable original sound”. Below that you should disable the first 2 of the 3 things on the menu. You should set to “disable” the “Suppress persistent background noise” and “Suppress intermittent background noise”.

(NOTE If you are using a smartphone or iPad, look under your “Settings” choose “Meetings” and then “Use Original Sound”)



For best sound and speed results you can purchase an Ethernet cable with USB adapter and plug your computer/laptop directly into your router. This will give you the best and fastest connection with the least distortion. If interested, we recommend the following: (both are very inexpensive on Amazon)

You would plug this Ethernet adapter into the USB on the computer.
